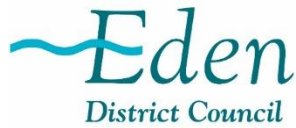

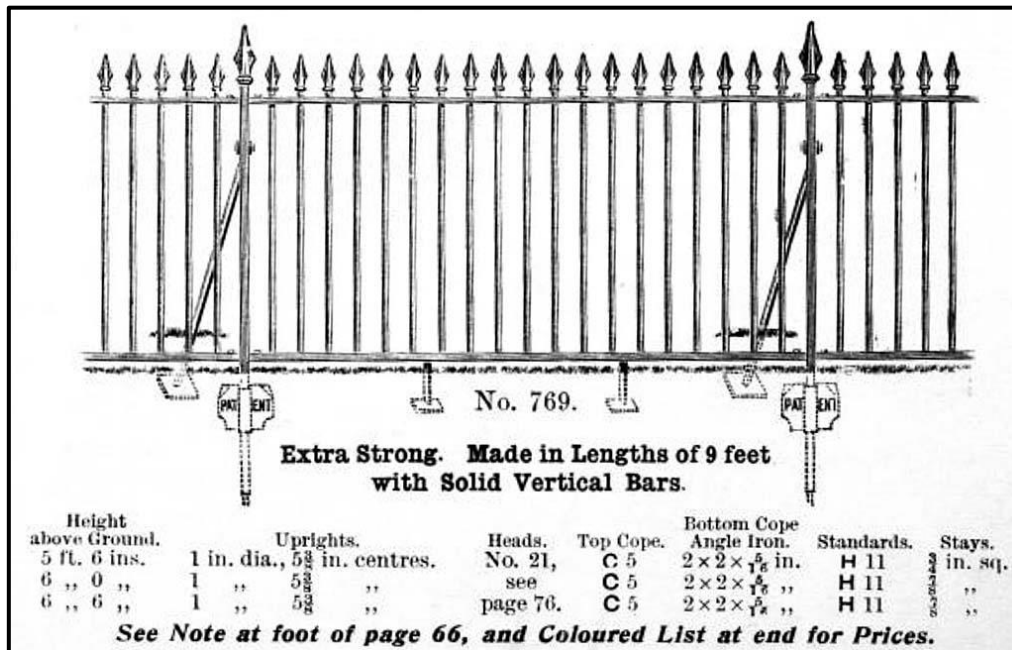

CONSERVATION, MAINTENANCE AND REPLACEMENT OF
TRADITIONAL CAST IRON RAILINGS

10.00 to 13.00 on Thursday 28th FEBRUARY 2019

A contract to conserve the 19th Century Railings damaged in the 2015 floods is underway at St Lawrence's Churchyard in the centre of Appleby. The works are using traditional skills to repair and replace the railings. The half day event will present and discuss the techniques used originally and the methods that are being used now. The presentation will include repairing cast iron, casting new iron components, preparation for redecoration and painting, stonework and using 'hot lead' to fix cast iron into stone. The event will be presented by the building contractor, metalworkers and architects involved in the contract.
